

# Valor Award

# **Nomination Application**

The Valor award is given to the SRO who displays heroism and distinction in extremely hazardous circumstances. To be considered for this honor, an SRO must exhibit unusual bravery in the performance of duty while facing threat of death or serious bodily injury. It is this committee's intent of this definition to base the award upon extraordinary actions that would expose the SRO to self-peril and beyond the call of duty.

### **Submission requirements:**

- 1. The Valor Award nomination form must be completed in full and submitted prior to the April 1 deadline.
- 2. A written submission need not exceed 1500 words.
- 3. An act of heroism which extends far beyond the normal call of duty where failure to take such action would not justify censure.
- 4. The act must include the actual risk of life and the nominee having had sufficient time to evaluate the risk.

#### **Selection Process:**

The deadline to submit the nomination form is **April 1**. Any late or incomplete nomination forms will not be considered. Nomination forms must be submitted via email to the awards committee awards@fasro.org

All award submissions will be reviewed and voted upon by the members of the Awards Committee. The individual who completed the nomination form will be notified once a selection is made if their SRO was chosen for the Valor Award.

# **Awarding of Achievement:**

The SRO chosen for the FASRO Valor award will be recognized during the opening ceremony at the annual FASRO conference.
